In this full-day workshop, you will construct the Tremont jacket by The Sewing Workshop. Linda Lee will have all of the sizes for you to try on to determine your best fit. The jacket can be made in almost any woven fabric of your choice as well as jacket-weight knits. You will learn how to sew acute mitered corners using Linda's signature technique, how to use pressing templates for perfect hems and edges, and good finishing solutions. Linda will also discuss underlining and lining options. Bring your own fabric or choose from a selection of kits from Linda. Kits are priced about \$50, depending upon fabric. Kits contain fabric only. You could make this as a vest if that is the style you prefer. Linda has a pdf online with instructions for changes needed.

Supplies:

- Tremont Jacket pattern (Linda will have them there - \$22.95 all sizes included)
- Fabric
- Matching thread
- 1 button, 3/4"
- Manilla file folder
- Chalk marker
- Pins
- Cutting tools - shears or rotary cutter and mat, trimming scissors
- Seam gauge
- 2" x 18" C-thru ruler
- Seam ripper
- Roll medical paper (available at Amazon)
- Prismacolor Col-Erase 20045 Carmine Red pencil with eraser
- Scotch Removable tape
- Hip curve (optional)
- Sewing Machine with Edgestitch foot and Buttonhole foot
- Serger

Tremont Jacket Loose-fitting, A-line jacket with one-button closure, asymmetric, angled front hemline with side vents. Three-quarter sleeves with soft-fold cuff detail.

Suggested Fabrics

Light to medium-weight wool cotton, knit, linen, silk, wool crepe, corduroy, novelty weaves, boucle, boiled wool.
