The Making of A Compass Bag (Noodle-Head Patterns)

Join us for this Don't Miss Event: Patsy will be teaching us how to make the Compass Bag by noodle-head.com. And the best part, it will be completed in one day!

Bag information:

Size – Small (9.5" W x 11" H x 4" Deep)

Adjustable Strap or Non-Adjustable (you choose)

Patsy will provide the following:

- All hardware for the bag (primarily silver color or antique bronze) to include:
- 2 - 1" D Rings
- 1 - 1" strap slider (if you choose adjustable strap)
- 2 - 1" swivel clips
- 4 - 9mm rivets
- 1 - 18mm magnetic snap with 2 small squares of Peltex as backing
- Woven interfacing & fusible fleece/Decovil Light (pre-cut for you)
- steam press
- rivet press
- hole punch

You will need to provide the following:

- Compass Bag Pattern – www.noodle-head.com \$10
- ½ yard of exterior fabric (home dec or heavy-type fabric)
- 1 yard of coordinating lining fabric (preferably a quilting cotton)
- 6" all-purpose zipper (I would NOT suggest a metal zipper) for interior pocket (maybe bring 2 if you have them – see *** below)
- ½ yard of accent fabric (used for side pockets without a flap – maybe a vinyl or heavy fabric – whatever your sewing machine can handle)

In the past, Patsy has coordinated her handle fabric with her pockets (She chose a marine vinyl).

***We will also discuss a quick pouch & tassel that coordinates with your bag. If we have time, we will either make them or you'll be given information on how to do that. Tassels will be made with vinyl – there will be remnant fabric available so we can play!
