Now he owns [Vector Quilts](#) where he designs paper pieced quilts and is a very proficient Longarm quilter. In addition to designing and quilting, teaching is another passion of his to share his love of quilting. David's teaching now

has him traveling all of the country to quilt shows and venues. We are very lucky to have him here locally and to find a spot on his calendar. So, don't miss this opportunity to learn from one of the best!

David will be teaching his **Equinox** pattern. The pattern colors are easily adaptable from warm to cool fabrics. Great for the beginner and seasoned paper piecer alike, everyone will walk away from the class with new skills and tips to make your paper piecing journey easier.

This class will open up a new quilting arena in your life and give you a solid foundation to explore the wonderful world of paper piecing.

Upon completion of the class and the quilt, you will have achieved a foundation of the basic concepts and use of the tools required and be prepared for more advanced projects.



#### Supply List:

- Required pattern (includes foundation papers) included in registration fee.
- Sewing Machine (cord and foot pedal) and basic sewing supplies
- 12" Add-a-Quarter Ruler (available for purchase the day of class)
- Elmer's Washable Glue Stick (available for purchase the day of class)

#### Fabric Requirements (recommended having extra in case of mistakes):

**These are the suggested colors. Students are welcome to select their own colors.**

- 2 3/4 yard White/Cream (Background Fabric)
- 1/8 yard Light Brown (Leaf stems)
- 1 1/4 yard Brown/Multi Color Batik (Leaves)

- 1/4 yard Light Blue Batik
- 1/4 yard Yellow/Green Batik
- 1/3 yard Orange Batik
- 1/3 yard Blue/Purple Batik
- 1/3 yard Dark Orange Batik
- 1/3 yard Purple Batik

**Skill Level:** Beginner/Novice

**Cost:** \$85 + \$15/pattern. Lunch is **NOT** included in the price of the workshop, please bring your lunch with you. Maximum of 8 students.
